WHEREAS, On September 20, 2020, Governor Murphy signed legislation which designated the third Friday in June as a State and public holiday, known as Juneteenth Day. Juneteenth commemorates June 19, 1865, when Union General Gordon Granger rode into Galveston, Texas to inform enslaved people of the 1863 Emancipation Proclamation and their freedom; and

WHEREAS, On Thursday, June 17, 2021, President Biden signed legislation making Juneteenth a federal holiday.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; by the Commissioners of the Wildwood Housing Authority that the Juneteenth holiday, as designated by the New Jersey state legislation, be added to the paid holiday calendar for Wildwood Housing Authority employees.
