A RESOLUTION APPROVING A TELECOMMUTING POLICY AND
PROCEDURES FOR THE WILDWOOD HOUSING AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of Wildwood, a Public body created and organized pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of the Laws of the State of New Jersey desires to designate a Telecommuting Policy and Procedures that allows agency to designate alternate work locations in order to promote general work efficiencies and to provide continuity of operations in the event employees must use an alternate work location; and

WHEREAS, the global coronavirus pandemic of 2020 initiated an unprecedented need for local governments to demonstrate flexibility through telecommuting in the workplace; and

WHEREAS, Telecommuting allows employees to work at home, on the road, or in a satellite location for all or part of their workweek. The Wildwood Housing Authority considers telecommuting to be a viable, flexible work option when both the employee and the job are suited to such an arrangement; and

WHEREAS, Employees may be required to telecommute or work from alternate work locations based on non-discriminatory operational needs of the Agency and/or an emergency event or circumstances beyond management's control; and

WHEREAS, Telecommuting is not an entitlement, it is not a companywide benefit, and it no way changes the terms and conditions of employment with the Wildwood Housing Authority

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners approves the proposed Telecommuting Policy and Procedures.
